Focus On Evangelism

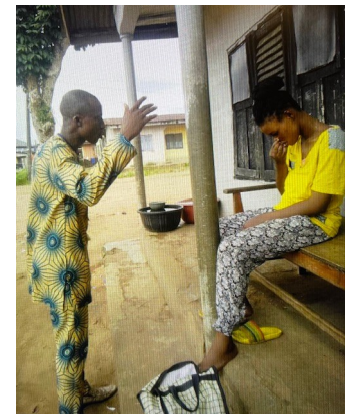
We began a marvelous journey in Nigeria despite the pandemic. In 2021, a door opened to work with Christ Foundation Liberation Ministry in Benin City. The first part of our work focused on evangelism. Our partner, Christ Foundation Liberation Ministry, spreads the Gospel on the streets, markets and business centers. Christ Foundation is a relatively new organization in this area. The aim of our project was to reach out to at least 70 unbelievers, win souls and guide them into the New Life in Christ.



We carried the project out in four phases. Each phase a day of outreach targeting specific locations in the city. We won over fifteen souls to Christ in these four phases. Some of them

Project Expansion

2020-2021 was another opportunity to close in on our goal of 12500 trees on the foothills of Mount Cameroon. Our partners in the field planted over 500 trees in 2020 and an additional 350 in 2021. We said in the last report the older trees planted in the 2014-2015 planting seasons grow exceptionally well. We also noticed none of the trees have been attacked by the mahogany shoot borer, *Hypsipyla grandella*. It is a piece of evidence that this parasite rarely attacks cedrela species on this part of the planet.

There are indications trees planted six years ago are near the time when they can produce flowers and seeds. In the past three years, we had difficulties getting seedlings to continue the project. Because of the current insecurities in the region, we couldn't get seedlings from trees planted by Wewuley Consultancy, our major supplier, in Moyuka. Most cedrela trees in nearby villages have been cut. The project will continue a lot smoother if our older trees

supply us with seedings.

Treff-End looks forward to the coming 2022-2023 planting seasons. And we keep working on strategies to encourage neighboring villagers to plant these trees in unused areas of their farmlands. Treff-End plans more workshops and training to encourage villagers to plant these valuable trees.

Cedrela Species

Cedrela is known to come originally from the Latin American forest of Mexico to Ecuador, Peru, Brazil and French Guyana. It grows very well in primary and secondary evergreen to semi-deciduous lowland and low mountainous forests. It grows very well in primary and secondary evergreen to semi-deciduous lowland and low mountainous forests.

Prefers fertile, free draining, weakly acidic soil, but also heavy soil, and demands few soil nutrients, tolerates soils high in calcium, and can resist long and severe periods of drought. Premier timber for furniture, decorative veneer, musical instruments, wooden novelties and doors. It is best used for cigar boxes, but also for light construction, mouldings, cabinets, panelling, boxes, exterior joinery, weather boards, louvered

doors, boat building (especially racing boats), canoes, turnery, matchboxes, household implements, plywood and firewood. It is also suitable for crates, fencing and animal pens. The repellent smell of the wood to insects makes it particularly suitable for the manufacture of clothing chests and wardrobe.

In the next phase, Treff-End wants to work with the villagers to open a carpentry training centre and explore new opportunities in line with the Cedrela project.
