We want to answer two questions in life. Paul asked these questions when Jesus intercepted him on his way to persecute Christians in Damascus. Acts 9. The questions are:

1- Who are You, Lord? Acts 9:5.

2- Lord, what do You want me to do? Acts 9:6.
